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




OUR MISSION

Thanks to You, Kids Get to Meet Up and Eat Up

The summer months pose a real challenge for struggling families. With schools closed for the long break, parents cannot rely on district meal programs to help keep their children fed. And with the persistently high cost of groceries and electricity, this summer is especially difficult.

To fill this gap, our *Meet Up and Eat Up* program helps children and teens in low-income areas receive the nourishing food they need.

Kids Cafe *Curbs*After-School *Hunger*

Melissa Sanchez has been
working with the Las VegasClark County Library
District for the past
three years. As the Youth
Services Librarian, she is
in charge of ordering all the
books for their children's
collection. But books aren't

the only resources kids can access at the library to learn and grow.

As one of Three Square's community partners, Melissa and her team operate *Kids Cafe*, an afterschool program that provides free meals to children between 2:00 and 4:00 in the afternoon. On an average day, they'll serve 25 to 30 meals. But recently, they've provided as many as 50 to 60 nutritious meals in a single afternoon, a reflection of the growing need in these challenging times.

"When middle school and elementary school lets out for the day, it can get very, very busy," Melissa says. "There's often a line to get the meals."

Helping children through *Kids Cafe* is extremely personal to Melissa, who grew up attending a Title 1 school in a lower socio-economic community. "We didn't have this," she says. "As a person in a similar situation to a lot of these folks who come in here, I just think about how great it would have been to have adults who wanted to support not only my education



but my nutrition too. I am immensely proud that we provide this program."

Through the support of generous friends like you, when school closes up for the summer, the library continues to provide free, fresh meals as one of our many *Meet Up and Eat Up* sites. (See page 2!)

"One in three low-income households report not having enough food," says Tara Nerida, Director of Programs at Three Square. "This program is particularly important because some kids do not always know where they are going to get their next meal if they are not in school."

Last summer, volunteers packed approximately 20,000 meals each week, which were distributed at over 85 locations across the valley. And with support from compassionate friends like you, we anticipate feeding even more kids this summer.

"This summer, we are hoping to serve nearly 100 sites across the valley, including 18 mobile route stops," Tara says. "I am so thankful for our partners, volunteers, and community for their dedication to ensuring that no child is left hungry. We are truly working together to provide innovative solutions that give children the meals they need to succeed and build a healthier community."

Meet Up and Eat Up is a crucial part of this effort, and we're very grateful for the role you play in making it happen.



Largest BackPack for Kids event in Three Square *History*

Approximately 75% of Clark County students rely on free and reduced-price meals. But what happens when school is out of session? Thanks to community partners like Smith's Food & Drug, children can access meals each weekend through our *BackPack for Kids* program.

Working with numerous donors, volunteers, and partners, Three Square provides bags filled with ready-to-eat meals each Friday. Recently, Smith's Food & Drug coordinated the largest single donation of backpacks by a community partner. From donating the food to rallying 270 volunteers, their group assembled 10,000 BackPack bags for local students.

This vital help won't end there. Thanks to friends like you, *BackPack for Kids* will continue to support children once school is back in session!
